

While the Library is closed in response to the COVID-19 health emergency:

- The automated exterior book drop is available.
- All due dates on currently checked out items have been extended to a **new due date of June 1, 2020**
- No overdue fines will accrue during this health emergency
- Patrons whose cards have expired since September 1, 2019 will have their cards renewed through May 31, 2020 or beyond.
- Due to Governor Evers' "Safer at Home" order, curbside pickup is not available at this time.

In an effort to expand access to **online resources** during this health emergency:

- Patrons with fines on their cards can still access the library databases, as well as, [Hoopla](#) and [OverDrive/Libby](#) by starting at [CountyCat](#)
- The number of titles each card holder can check out from *Hoopla* has been temporarily raised to 8 per month
